

Approach

Whitsunday Regional Council held 'Coastal Conversations' in December 2019 to inform the community about coastal hazards and ask for their input into how WRC will manage these hazards.

The feedback sessions were held at Bowen, Cannonvale, Conway Beach, Dingo Beach, Hydeaway Bay and Wilsons Beach.

Residents were invited to attend any of these sessions and were provided with a survey to complete at the end of the session.

Attendees were given copies of hazard mapping which WRC has recently completed as part of the Coastal Hazard Adaptation Strategy.

Next Steps

The Consultation Report will be presented to Council and included in State Government reporting. The feedback will be considered during the development of coastal adaptation options in the future, and further engagement with affected communities will occur.


82 people attended and54 surveys were submitted


Coastal Conversations - how would you like to see your coastline managed, now and into the future?
